ATTENDANCE

Coming to school regularly is an integral part of student's life. This inculcates discipline and regularity in a student, which in turn creates moral value and holistic education gained by a child in the school environment. **No student will be allowed to enter the class without a leave application if he/she has been absent the previous day.**

Leave of Absence:

1. Students who have been **sick** for more than **2 days** will bring a **medical certificate** from their doctor on re-joining the School.
2. All students will attend school on the reopening day after each of the vacations. Those absent will be fined at the rate of Rs. 100/- per day. Those absent on account of any illness must present a medical certificate before they are admitted to the class. It is compulsory for all students to maintain regular attendance during the course of the Academic Session, **75% attendance is mandatory** to enable them to appear for the Final Assessment. The percentage, however, could be relaxed on medical grounds. **A certificate of merit will be given to students with 100% attendance.**
3. **If a child is absent from the school without prior information for 7 days continuously then his/her name will be struck off from the attendance register.**

GUIDELINES TO PARENTS

If you want your child to do well in school then you yourself must develop a respect for learning.

1. Read school circulars, notes and remarks sent by teachers carefully.
2. Encourage your child to take interest in academics, co-curricular activities and sports.
3. Communicate to the teacher any matter of concern with regard to the feedback you receive from the child, that may help the child gain confidence.
4. Any change in address or telephone no. must be intimated to school office at the earliest.
5. Make sure the child returns the library books in time, failing which a fine will be charged and the library facility will be withdrawn.
6. Monthly Evaluation Report (MER) for every child will be displayed on the website (if required).
7. Taking leave during working days is strongly discouraged. Parents are responsible to make up for the loss of the studies in case of leave taken. The school will expect these students to be at par with the class in every way and that will have to be ensured by the parents.
8. Missing out on Weekly Tests and Activity Based Evaluations directly affect the promotion of the students to the next class at the end of the session. Thus taking up all the Formative and Summative Assessments places the student on a safer pedestal and decides a better place in the class. Please take these Tests/Evaluations seriously for the betterment of your ward.
9. It has been observed with dismay that students turn up late to the school which is undesirable. Henceforth **latecomers** will be **sent back home**. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
10. Read the School Almanac frequently as they carry all the details needed for the session.
11. Transport facility can be availed for pre destined routes & stoppages only. Moreover, no new route or stoppage will be earmarked for the new session. Neither the bus will stop for more than 5-10 seconds at any particular stoppage.

12. Students are expected to attend school in neat and well ironed, complete uniform and boys with short and decent hair cut. In case of non-compliance, they will **not** be allowed to **attend classes** and parents shall be called to take them home. Kindly ensure that the instructions are followed in all seriousness to avoid any inconvenience to your good self later, as the students will not be adjusted and sent home in the next shift bus.
13. It is mandatory for the students using personal conveyance (Two Wheelers) to school to wear helmets and carry license. They are only allowed to ride 50cc bikes as per the notification of Traffic Police Department.
14. It is wonderful to observe children distribute toffees on their Birthday. It would be still better if an amount is contributed to the B'day box so that it could be utilized for the underprivileged children and the children learn the value of charity. Birthdays to be celebrated through distribution of toffees to friends. No cakes, pastries, cold drinks, chocolate bars, chewing gum and fancy gifts permitted. **Partying** in the classroom or canteen is strictly **prohibited**. It is reiterated that birthday joy shared is joy doubled. Hence sharing of birthday festivities with the underprivileged will be highly appreciated. Students of classes VI-XII must **wear** school **uniform** on their birthdays.
15. **Do not** provide any extra money beyond **Rs. 50/-** to your wards. If extra money is found in their possession, it will be **confiscated**.
16. Encourage your ward to speak in English.
17. Motivate your child to maintain a proper code of conduct. Any misbehaviour or indiscipline may lead to serious consequence including a heavy fine.
18. No sharp objects namely blade, knife, scissors, needle should be sent to school to ensure safety.
19. Valuable articles like gold/ diamond jewellery (chain & danglers), facial make up like eye make up & bindi, henna decorating palms & feet is strictly prohibited in the school. **Electronic gadgets** (mobiles, i-pod , camera etc) are not permitted inside the school premises as per CBSE school rules. If found, the articles will be **confiscated** and will be **returned only after 6 months**. If such instances are **repeated**, then the child may be asked to **leave** the school.
20. In an initiative to **conserve forest** through the minimal use of paper, the school administration has decided to do away with **printed circulars**. Instead, the circulars will be put on the school website **www.dpsraipur.com**. Please log on to the official website every Friday to check the weekly circular. Kindly go through the Almanac of your ward frequently as it facilitates communication between the parent and the school.
21. In the fast paced age of computers, it is mandatory for all the stakeholders of DPS Raipur to possess their personal E-mail IDs as the Monthly Evaluation Sheet (CCE) and other vital information pertaining to your ward will be sent to the inbox via electronic mail. Kindly check it regularly to access report of your ward.

SCHOOL HONOURS AND AWARDS

- **Scholar Badge** : A Scholar Badge shall be awarded to a student for achieving academic excellence with 80 % and above (class V onwards). Attendance should be 90 % and above
- **Scholar Blazer** : A Scholar Blazer shall be awarded to a student who earns the Scholar Badge for three consecutive years. (class V and above). Attendance should be 90 % and above.

Note :- No medical case for exemption will be considered.
